FRANK RICHARDS

8 August 1876 – 24 Dec 1961

was one of the most prolific children's authors of all time. Born Charles Hamilton, his first published work was a short story issued when he was just 17. His total output was



estimated to be in excess of 75,000,000 words by the *Guiness Book of Records*, writing under 28 different pen names.

Richards's most famous fictional creation is undoubtedly Billy Bunter. The overweight tuck scoffer began life as a fairly minor character in the Greyfriars School stories printed in Magnet. Richards also created Tom Merry, who, along with all the boys at St Jim's, was a stalwart of Gem magazine until it was closed in 1939. Meanwhile Bunter and Co. survived Magnet's closure through books, television, and the theatre.

With such a huge bibliography, we have chosen to concentrate on books by Frank Richards, but have also included a round-up of all the rarest magazines to feature his work.
